6 Minute English Shadowing Practice – Talk About Shopping in English | Slow English Podcast

Hello everyone! Welcome to Easy English Practice.

Do you sometimes feel nervous when shopping in English?

For example, you go into a shop, but you do not know how to ask for something, how to ask about the price, or how to pay.

Many English learners know words like buy, price, shop, but they cannot make full sentences when they need to talk to a shop assistant.

So, let us get started

Let us begin with entering the shop.

When you walk into a shop, you can start with a simple greeting.

For example, you can say:

“Good morning.”

“Good afternoon.”

Or simply, “Hello.”

After that, you can ask for something you need.

For example:

“Do you sell shoes?”

“I am looking for a T-shirt.”

“Can you help me, please?”

Now, repeat these sentences with me:

“Good morning.”

This is shadowing. Listen and repeat with me.

It will help you speak faster and more naturally.

You can also make your question more specific.

For example:

“I am looking for black shoes.”

“I want a small T-shirt.”

“Do you have this in medium size?”

Let us repeat together:

Great job! Now you can enter a shop and ask for something in simple English.

Now let us move to the next step: asking about prices

When you want to know the price, you can ask simple questions.

For example:

“How much is this?”

“How much are these shoes?”

“What is the price of this T-shirt?”

Now, repeat these sentences with me:

“How much is this?”

This is shadowing. Listen and repeat with me.

It will help you speak faster and more naturally.

Sometimes, you want to know if the item is cheaper.

You can ask:

“Is this on sale?”

“Do you have a discount?”

“Is there a cheaper one?”

Let us repeat together:

“Is this on sale?”

“Do you have a discount?”

Great! You are learning how to ask about prices clearly.

If you want to try something before buying, you can say:

“Can I try it on?”

“Can I see this in a different color?”

“Do you have this in large size?”

Now repeat with me:

“Can I try it on?”

“Can I see this in a different color?”

“Do you have this in large size?”

Excellent! Now you know how to ask about prices and check items in English.

After asking about the price, the next step is paying for your items

When you decide to buy something, you can say:

“I will take this one.”

“I would like to buy this.”

“This is perfect for me.”

Now, repeat these sentences with me:

“I will take this one.”

“I would like to buy this.”

“This is perfect for me.”

Great! That is shadowing. Listen and repeat with me.

When you are at the cashier, you may ask about payment.

You can say:

“Can I pay by card?”

“Do you accept cash?”

“Can I pay with my phone?”

Let us repeat together:

“Can I pay by card?”

“Do you accept cash?”

“Can I pay with my phone?”

Sometimes you need a bag for your items.

You can ask:

“Do you have a bag, please?”

“Can you give me a small bag?”

“I need a bag for these items.”

Now repeat with me:

“Do you have a bag, please?”

“Can you give me a small bag?”

“I need a bag for these items.”

Great job! Now you know how to pay in English and ask for small things politely.

After paying, you may want to talk about your shopping experience and share your feelings

After shopping, it is nice to share your opinion or feelings.

You can use short and simple sentences like:

“This shop is very nice.”

“I like this color.”

“The price is good.”

Now, repeat these sentences with me:

“This shop is very nice.”

“I like this color.”

Sometimes you want to say something more personal.

For example:

“I enjoyed shopping here.”

“I feel happy with my new clothes.”

“I was surprised by the low prices.”

Let us repeat together:

“I enjoyed shopping here.”

You can also express your opinion about the service.

For example:

“The staff were very friendly.”

“The shop was clean and comfortable.”

“I will come back again.”

Repeat with me:

“The staff were very friendly.”

“The shop was clean and comfortable.”

“I will come back again.”

Great! Now you can describe your shopping feelings and give your opinion in English.

After this, let us move to some tips that will help you practice shopping English every day

Here are some useful tips to make your speaking practice more effective:

Speak daily, even for 5 minutes. Consistency is more important than long hours once a week.

Record yourself. Listening back will help you notice pronunciation or grammar mistakes.

Shadow podcasts or videos. Repeat after the speaker with the same rhythm and intonation.

Use simple sentences first. Do not worry about advanced grammar in the beginning.

Think in English. Try to describe what you are doing during the day in English.

Do not fear mistakes. Mistakes are part of learning and show that you are trying.

Ask for feedback. If possible, practice with a friend or teacher who can correct you.

Remember: speaking is like a muscle. The more you use it, the stronger it becomes
